Who hasn't heard of Rio's famous Carnival and beautiful beaches? (And of course, the beautiful people in swimsuits!) I've got my sunblock and my swimsuit packed. But I'm leaving my MP3 player at home. I'll miss my music but... I'm sure it'll be OK!

India has always fascinated me – the colours, the sounds. The tastes, the smells! I'm so happy to be visiting there! I think I'll even like the hot weather! But I'm getting prepared for the dust, dirt, noise, pollution, and mosquitoes, too.

A

It's very hot, polluted, and dusty here, so light fabrics will help you keep cool. The society is very traditional, so men should take pants, women should take skirts below knee. Women should not wear shorts or blouses that show much skin. You must have a hat, sunglasses, and sunblock. Soap, toilet, tissue, and sprays to kill insects should be carried with you at all times in a small bag.

B

Summers in this city are warm, but winter are freezing, with lots of ice and snow. If you're coming here between December and March, pack a heavy winter coat, sweaters, boots, gloves, a scarf, and a warm hat that covers your ears. You should also pack rubber-soled shoes to avoid slipping on the ice. If you are here in summer, though, be sure to pack a swimsuit for a quick jump in one of our lakes.

C

Our summer begins in November when it gets very hot, and our winter starts in May, when it gets cool at night. Shorts, t-shirts and sun dresses are OK, but a sweater and long pants are good at night to protect you from insect bites. Long pants are very necessary if you plan to go on safari. And be sure to check with your doctor about anti-malaria pills.

D

You should be ready for cool, rainy weather any time of year here, so remember to bring your umbrella and a rain coat. Be sure to bring at least two pairs of shoes, so if one pair gets wet you won't have to walk around with wet feet all day. Also, don't forget to pick up a free copy of underground map.

E

We have warm temperatures year-round, but it can be rainy from November to April. Be sure to bring several swimsuits, a snorkel and mask so you can watch our beautiful fish under the surface of the sea. Pack long pants and sweaters if you plan to climb to the top of our volcanoes. But otherwise we're very casual here, so shorts and t-shirts are always OK.

F

Our spring starts in September and our winter starts in June. But it's always comfortable here, so a swimsuit, sunscreen and sunglasses are very necessary at any of our year-round beaches. Don't be afraid to take even a tiny swimsuit or a fancy dancing costume, we just like to party and dance! But do not bring any valuables. It will make you a target for pickpockets, sorry to say.

G

You'll want to be comfortable whether you're visiting the Capitol or other monuments, dining in a fine restaurant or attending meetings. So choose lightweight suits for our hot summers and heavy coats and sweaters for our snowy, cold winter. All the government buildings are air-conditioned. Be careful if you travel by Metro because of pickpockets.
